District and Community:

MCHS student enrollment is currently 708 students. A high percentage of students attend Marengo High School for all four years. Racial/Ethnic background for MCHS students is as follows: 76.4% white, 19.9% Hispanic, 0.1% American Indian, 0.6% Black, 1.3% Asian. 31.1% of students come from a low-income background, 1.4% are considered Limited-English-Proficient, and 0.4% of students are classified as Homeless.

Honors Classes (18): English I, English II, English III, College Writing, Humanities (9, 10,& 11), Geometry, Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, Accelerated Biology, Accelerated Chemistry, Physics, Advanced Biology, Accounting II, Spanish III, Spanish IV, and Mandarin Chinese IV

** Please note that students earn AP gpa weight & complete the AP English Literature exam, but the class is not an official Advanced Placement curriculum.*
